

## Corona virus information, date 01/07/2021

The WoVe regularly follows the latest developments and provides information on measures taken to protect employees, cleaning staff or craftsmen and to prevent the spreading among tenants. ### Operational changes and instructions from WoVe

- The office hours will resume as usual from July 6th, 2021.
- A party ban applies to all WoVe properties.
- During cleaning work by cleaning staff, access to the rooms they are working in is blocked.
- Please read the notices from WoVe in your property and follow the instructions of the staff.

### Current measures for tenants of WoVe

- Please follow the general rules of conduct of the Swiss Confederation and the cantons BS / BL
- Special hygiene measures in the shared kitchens and wet rooms to be followed:  
Please observe the hygiene measures in the kitchen and in the wet rooms. You must clean the kitchen and the used eating and kitchen utensils well after each use. Using normal household cleaners is sufficient. The same applies after using the sanitary facilities. Also very important is the distance to other people. Try to keep the social distance (2m), especially in the general areas (dining room/common room/living room). **Regular ventilation is very important!**
- In case an infection is suspected - what should I do?  
If you suspect that you are infected with Covid 19, you should call your family doctor immediately for an initial assessment. If you don't have a family doctor, you can e.g. contact medix-toujours (<https://www.medix-toujours.ch/en/>). If your illness is confirmed or suspected, please also contact us immediately ([info@wove.ch](mailto:info@wove.ch)) and let us know. So we can plan the next steps and reassess the rules of conduct.

## Measures in case of suspected cases in the shared apartment

If a resident of the shared apartment shows symptoms of a coronavirus infection, increased precautionary measures should be taken:

- Discuss your individual measures by telephone with your family doctor or the cantonal medical emergency number: <http://www.mnzbasel.ch/de.html>.
  - Immediately inform all your roommates and us via E-mail: [info@wove.ch](mailto:info@wove.ch) and take the precautionary measures mentioned below.
  - All roommates should avoid direct contact with the sick person. If not possible wear masks and keep the distance of 2m.
  - All surfaces that the sick person has touched and used should be cleaned well after use.
  - The sick person should not enter the communal kitchen and dining room, and should use separate everyday objects (dishes, towels, etc.)
  - If possible, we will provide your own bathroom / toilet in the shared apartment
  - If this is not possible, the surfaces must be thoroughly cleaned with household cleaners and disinfectants after each use.

- Please understand the tenants who are in self-isolation or quarantine.
  - Supports others in self-isolation / quarantine in compliance with distance and hygiene measures. For example: Put food in front of the room, do the shopping, offer moral support, etc.
